MEDICAL INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR GRADES 1 THROUGH 12

All newly entering students in grades 1 through 12 must meet the medical requirements listed below. Students from outside the United States must meet Illinois requirements even though their country of origin follows a different immunization schedule. Medical forms for newly entering students are due before the first day of school. Incoming **FRESHMAN** must submit medical forms before departing for Freshman retreat. If your child cannot meet the medical requirements before the beginning of the school year, it is advisable to contact the school Medical Office (773 - 702 - 9452) or the Admissions Office (773 - 702 - 9451). Forms should be directed to the Medical Office, Blaine 107.

1. A physical examination completed within a year prior to entry. This must be signed and dated by a physician, physician's assistant or nurse practitioner.

2. A complete record (month/day/year) of immunizations including:

DTaP/DPT (Diphtheria/Pertussis/Tetanus)

Five immunizations, the last given at or after 4 years of age. (Four are acceptable if the last is given after 4 years of age.)

Td booster 10 years after the preschool booster, usually in 9th or 10th grade.

IPV/OPV (Inactivated or Oral Polio Vaccine)

Four immunizations, the last given at or after 4 years of age. (Three are acceptable if the last is given after 4 years of age.)

MMR (Measles/Mumps/Rubella)

A first immunization **at or after one year of age.** Please note that a Measles immunization given before a year of age does not count as the first of the two required Measles immunizations.

MMR or Measles booster

All students in grades 1 - 12 must have a second Measles or MMR shot.

Hepatitis B Required of all students entering grades 4 through 12 in Fall, 2006

A **tuberculosis skin test** is required of every newly entering student and of returning students during Middle School or High School.

Requests for medical or religious exemption from physical exams and/or immunizations must be submitted in writing. Medical exemption is based on a signed statement from a physician specifying the reason for the contraindication. Request for religious exemption must set out the specific religious belief that conflicts with examination and/or immunizations. Under Illinois law, the Laboratory Schools administration is responsible for determining the validity of the request.
