MEDICAL INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR NURSERY SCHOOL

All children attending nursery school in Illinois must meet the medical requirements listed below. Physical exams and immunization records for newly entering children must be submitted before they begin attending class. Children from outside the United States must meet Illinois requirements even though their country of origin may have a different immunization schedule. Any child whose immunizations do not meet Illinois requirements may be subject to a change of class or may be requested to delay entry until the immunizations are given. If you cannot meet the medical requirements before the beginning of school, it is advisable to contact the Medical Office (773-702-9452) or the Admissions office (773-702-9451). Forms should be directed to the Medical Office, Blaine 107.

1. A documented physical examination completed within a year prior to entry. This must be signed and dated by a licensed physician.

2. A complete record (month/day/year) of immunizations including:

**DTaP/DPT** (Diphtheria/Pertussis/Tetanus) - four immunizations

**IPV/OPV** (Inactive Polio Vaccine/Oral Polio Vaccine) - three immunizations

**MMR** (Measles/Mumps/Rubella)

One immunization at or after one year of age. **Please note that a Measles immunization given before a year of age does not meet the State requirement.**

**Hib** (Haemophilus influenza Type B) - all children under 5 years of age.

**Hepatitis B** All children attending nursery school programs are required to complete a series of three doses.

**Varicella** – all children entering nursery school.

A **tuberculosis skin test** is required of every child entering school.

A **lead screening test** is required of all children under 6 years of age. If a lead test is not indicated, your physician should document this on the school form.

Requests for medical or religious exemption from physical exams and/or immunizations must be submitted in writing. Medical exemption is based on a signed statement from a physician specifying the reason for the contraindication. Request for religious exemption must set out the specific religious belief that conflicts with examination and/or immunizations. Under Illinois law, the Laboratory Schools administration is responsible for determining the validity of the request.
